While there is no required certification in the state of Vermont, we do have a training program and voluntary certification process. The following link is to a document explaining this process:

The path by which many assessors/Listers have come into this industry is to serve as a Lister in your home town. You must be elected if your town still has a Board of Listers, but many towns have voted to replace the Board of Listers with a hired assessor or assessor's department.
